Scope and Contents

The Lenny Bruce collection consists of photographs, writings and transcripts, correspondence, news clippings and articles, audio recordings and trial materials, all related to Lenny Bruce's performances and life, as well as some materials relating to his family members. Of particular note is the large collection of photographs of Lenny Bruce, Honey Bruce (his wife), Kitty Bruce (his daughter), Sally Marr (his mother) and Myron Schneider (his father), among others. The photographs document not only his professional career but also his personal life with family and friends. Also of note are the audio recordings, which include excerpts or full recordings of some of Bruce's performances between 1958 and 1966. A small amount of these audio recordings are personal recordings made by Bruce, such as conversations with friends and family, between 1959 and 1960. The writings and transcripts offer transcripts of his performances as well as showcase screenplays he had written as well as ones written about him. The series Correspondence, Writings and transcripts, and News clippings and articles also have materials pertaining to Lenny Bruce previously gathered by a close friend named Ralph J. Gleason, who was a journalist for the San Francisco Chronicle and later, the founding editor for Rolling Stone

Magazine. The materials range in date from the early 1920s to the 2000s, with the bulk of the items being created between 1958 and 1966.

Content Description

This series contains photographs relating to Lenny Bruce in his lifetime as well as people and other things associated with him. The photographs are arranged approximately by date and divided into sub series: "Lenny Bruce" contains photographs of Lenny alone, including headshots, his mug shot, and images from his trial. "Lenny Bruce and Kitty Bruce" includes photos of family vacations, trips to the circus and professional shots with only Kitty. "Lenny Bruce and Honey Bruce" includes wedding photos, vacation photos, and a scene from their act together. "Lenny Bruce and Family" includes Lenny with multiple family members including his mother Sally Marr, his father and stepmother Myron and Dorothy Schneider, as well as Honey and Kitty. Also included are family photo albums, and family photographs that don't include Lenny and/or are after he has passed. "Lenny Bruce and Others" are photographs of Lenny at clubs and performances, with friends and colleagues, and some of his trial. Lastly, "Other photographs" contains photographs that are related to Lenny, like a sculpture, billboards and marquees, as well as contain photographs of other people that aren't immediately identified as family members. The materials included are photographs and negatives, with some slides and negative disks.

Content Description

This series consists primarily of audio recordings, including reel-to-reel audio tapes, compact cassette tapes, 45 records, and compact discs, relating to Lenny Bruce and his career. It also includes one VHS tape. The series is divided into three sub-series: 1. Stand-up comedy performances, 2. Private recordings, and 3. Promotional material and other recordings

Sub-series 1: Stand up comedy performances consists of recordings of Lenny Bruce's public performances at various venues between 1958 and 1966, including the Den, the Gate of Horn, Club Renaissance, and Off Broadway, among others. These recordings are arranged chronologically. Many of these recordings are whole or partial recordings of the same performance (with variations in audio quality), or combination clips from various performances.

Sub-series 2: Private recordings is arranged chronologically and contains recordings of Lenny Bruce at home or in other private locations. Most of these recordings are of a more personal nature, such as the phone letters and private conversations between Bruce and his friends and family. This sub-series also contains an interview with Bruce and compilations of free-form bits Bruce recorded at home before his death in August 1966. One of these recordings, LB_55b, contains clips from one of Bruce's performances at the Off Broadway club in San Francisco, CA.

Recordings in the Stand up comedy performances and Private recordings sub-series were reformatted to digital files with a grant from The GRAMMY Foundation® Grant Program. Clips and in-depth descriptions of these recordings are available in the Brandeis Institutional Repository. The full recordings are available for use in the department and researchers are requested to use the digital files.

Sub-series 3: Promotional material and other recordings consists mainly of compilation recordings published to market the concert album, "Lenny Bruce - Live at the Curran Theater," (1971) and the boxed set, "Let the Buyer Beware," (2004). The compilation recordings are on 45s and compact discs and were published between 1971 and 2004. This sub-series also contains a VHS tape recording of "Dream Follies" a film written by Bruce in 1954.
