Biographical / Historical

Marcia Freedman is an American-Israeli women's rights and peace activist. Born in the United States in 1938, Freedman emigrated to Israel in 1967. During the early seventies, she was a founder and leader of the feminist movement in Israel. In 1973 she was elected to the Knesset and served until 1977 as a member of the Citizens Rights Movement. During her tenure, she advocated for women's issues and feminist reform in Israel. As a result of her work, the Youth Ministry's budget for girls in distress was increased and wife battering in Israel was investigated. She also introduced legislation that led to the reform of Israel's highly restrictive abortion law. She co-founded the Women's Party in 1977. In 1977 she also opened the first battered women's shelter in Israel and helped create a network of support and services for women. She returned to the United States in 1981 and was active in women's and peace issues. In 1990 she published her memoirs, *Exile in the Promised Land*, to wide acclaim. She again returned to Israel for extended stays from 1997 to 2002, helping to found the Community School for Women, which offered courses in women's studies to disadvantaged women in Israel. She was also the founding president of Brit Tzedek v'Shalom in 2002, also known as Jewish Alliance for Justice and Peace.

Scope and Contents

The Marcia Freedman papers consist of journals, speeches, lecture notes, correspondence, manuscripts, typescripts, and research files created by Marcia Freedman, an American-Israeli activist and feminist. The collection also contains many articles about Freedman, including newspaper clippings, as well as book reviews for her memoir *Exile in the Promised Land*. Of particular note are materials documenting her feminist roots, files relating to her election to the Knesset in Israel in 1973 and her founding of the Women's Party in Israel in 1977, as well as autobiographical writings throughout the collection. Material dates from the late 1960s to the 2010s. There is also some audiovisual material and born-digital mixed media files, such as diskettes, CDs, and flash drives (some of which consists of as-yet unidentified content). Collection is predominantly in English, though there are also many newspaper clippings in Hebrew; some European languages are also represented.

Scope and Contents

As the first woman elected to the Knesset (Israel's parliament), this series includes newspaper clippings of Freedman's early work with the Jewish feminist movement, newspaper clippings covering Freedman's election to the Knesset, notes of congratulations to Freedman about her election, as well as miscellaneous documents and materials produced during her time serving on the Knesset, including drafts of speeches, correspondence related

to her work with battered women, and a document outlining the platform of the Women's Party in Israel, which Freedman helped found. The bulk of materials in this series dates to the mid-1970s. Arranged chronologically by oldest to most recent.

Includes handwritten letters to Natalie Rein, author of "Daughters of Rachel: Women in Israel", as well as many personal emails discussing the women's peace movement in Israel and the political climate in Israel and Palestine from 1997 to 2002. Dealing with the same subject matter, Freedman's personal journal, typewritten, is also available in this series. Finally, includes two bound booklets of 22 years of transcribed conversations of the Wandering Menstruals, a support/discussion group for aging women, of which Freedman was a prominent member. Scope and Contents

This series includes articles, commentaries, and papers written by Freedman, on the topics of sexism, feminism, philosophy, Israel, and others. Some appear to be original typewritten copies, while others made their way into various publications, including newspapers, magazines, and academic journals. Also includes several incomplete manuscripts Freedman worked on through various stages of her career. Writings about Freedman include many newspaper clippings about her life's work, as well as numerous reviews of her memoir titled "Exile in the Promised

Land". Publications include programs for Jewish holidays and materials dealing with Freedman's work as founding president with the organization Brit Tzedek v'Shalom. Arranged alphabetically by title.
