## Biographical Note

---

Murray Rosenblum was an American soldier who fought in World War II. Rosenblum was born on June 15, 1917. He lived in Brooklyn, New York and worked as a salesman for Oakdale Woolen Company from 1938-1943 before the beginning of the Second World War. From 1943-1945, Rosenblum served in the Army as a master sergeant with the 99th General Hospital in France. While deployed, he spent time in Berlin, Paris, Luxembourg, Belgium, and the Buchenwald concentration camp. He was honorably discharged on November 20, 1945 after his service and the end of the war.

## Scope and Contents

---

This collection consists of approximately 500 photographs belonging to Murray Rosenblum, who served as a sergeant in the 99th General Hospital, Verdun, France, during World War II. The photographs were taken between 1944 and 1945 and cover Rosenblum's service in the Army, from basic training until the end of the war. The images show Rosenblum with his army friends at the hospital and in various other locations including Germany, France, Luxembourg, Belgium (around the time of the Battle of the Bulge) and Wales. Some pictures depict the soldiers on R&R. Of particular note are photographs taken soon after the liberation of the Buchenwald concentration camp in Germany. The collection also contains images of Berlin on or around VE day (including a photograph of Rosenblum with a Russian female soldier before the Brandenburg Gate) and pictures of destroyed buildings in Berlin, Frankfurt and Leipzig. The collection is unprocessed.
